## 2022 DESIGN AWARDS: CALL FOR ENTRIES

### AWARDS

Architectural Awards for built work will be considered at the following levels:

**Award for Excellence** will be given for the project that exemplifies the highest design at the Jury's discretion.

**Honor Award(s)** will be given for projects that exemplify a high design quality.

**COTE Award of Excellence** given to the project that demonstrates excellence across all measures of the AIA Framework for Design Excellence

### CATEGORIES

The Jury will determine the categories based on the nature of the projects submitted. As appropriate, the project categories may be judged according to project size and/or construction costs.

**Small Projects** – Projects less than \$500,000 in construction costs OR under 2,000 SF will be considered for the Small Projects award category. Limited to small firms of nine (9) or fewer fulltime employees at the time of completion.

**COTE Award of Excellence** – Projects must include demonstrated excellence across all measures of the AIA Framework for Design Excellence (see AIAPA form) or documented proof of LEED.

### ELIGIBILITY

AIA Bucks County member Firms and/or member architects are eligible to submit projects for which they are the ARCHITECT OF RECORD and in good standing. A member in good standing is defined as one who has paid their dues by the 31<sup>st</sup> of March for the year of the Design Awards Program.

Eligible projects for this year's program must have been completed after December 31, 2017. There are no geographic limits for these projects. Projects that have previously received an AIA Bucks County Award are not eligible for submission. Number of entries is limited to three (3) per firm.

### SUBMISSION FORMAT

The awards submissions are to be anonymous.

Each submission must include the following:

(which is enclosed with this invitation). The form shall be submitted as a separate PDF in the project submission folder.

- In a PDF formatted to 8½ x 11, provide adequate information to explain the project and design intention. This may include scans, drawings and narrative, etc. All artwork shall be formatted to 8 1/2 x 11 inch. (150 dpi) or images of photographs (4 x 6 inches). PDF is limited to 4 pages maximum.
- Three high resolution images submitted as separate files in the project submission folder. Jpegs, PNGs, TIFs are acceptable. Image files may be a maximum of 5MB per image.

### SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

Place a copy of all required files into a Google Drive folder and share the folder with [aiabucksawards@gmail.com](mailto:aiabucksawards@gmail.com). For applicants submitting more than one project, submit each project separately in its own individual folder. Follow the naming structure identified in the below graphic.

The name of the folder for each submitted project should be the Project Name as identified on the Project Information Form.

### SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Registration must be received no later than 5:00 PM on **October November 7, 2022** via Google Drive.

### REGISTRATION FEES

\$50 for Each Entry. (Up to three)
