2024 DESIGN AWARDS – CALL FOR ENTRIES

AWARDS

Architectural Awards for built work will be considered at the following levels:

Award for Excellence: Given to the project that exemplifies the highest design at Jurors discretion.

Honor Award(s): Given to project(s) that exemplify a high design quality.

COTE Award of Excellence: Given to the project that demonstrates excellence across all measures of the AIA Framework for Design Excellence.

Small Project Award: Given to a project with construction costs less than \$500,000.

The Juror will determine the number of awards given based on the submissions received for various project types and construction costs. There may not be an award granted in each project type as it is up to the discretion of the Juror based on the submissions received.

ELIGIBILITY

AIA Bucks County member Firms and/or Architects are eligible to submit projects for which they are the Architect of Record. A member in good standing is defined as one who has paid their dues by the 31st of March for the year of the Design Awards Program.

Eligible projects for this year's program must have been completed after December 31, 2019. There are no geographic limits for these projects.

Projects that have previously received an AIA Bucks County Award are not eligible for submission.

There is no limit to the number of entries per firm.

SUBMISSION FORMAT






The awards submissions are to be anonymous. Each submission **must** include the following:

- A completed Project Information Form (enclosed herein). The form shall be submitted as a separate PDF in the project submission folder.
- In a PDF formatted to 8½ x 11, provide adequate information to explain the project and design intention. This may include scans, drawings and narrative, etc. All artwork shall be formatted to 8 1/2 x 11 inch. (150 dpi) or images of photographs (4 x 6 inches). PDF is limited to 4 pages maximum.
- Three high resolution images submitted as separate files in the project submission folder.
- Floor plans and architectural building plans for the project.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

Place a copy of all required files into a Google Drive folder and share the folder with aiabucksawards@gmail.com. For applicants submitting more than one project, submit each project separately in its own project folder. The name of the project folder should be the Project Name as identified on the Project Information Form. Please follow the naming conventions identified in the below graphic.
